Local Foods Plymouth Farmer/Grower Rules

It is the responsibility of the Farmer/Grower to:

Comply with the New Hampshire Department of Agriculture pertaining to items they sell through Local Foods Plymouth, including licensing and certification.

Use certified scales if selling by weight. The NH Weekly Market Bulletin is a good standard guide to market prices (www.state.nh.us/agric/aghome.html)

Deliver all pre-purchased product by 2:30pm on pickup days, packaged in the pre-arranged quantities.

Indicate farm or farmer and product name preferably on all food packages. This practice helps build name recognition for farmers. LFP can help create labels for farmers.

Provide accurate information about food availability to the Local Foods Plymouth administrators for posting on the website.

Eligibility of farmer/growers:

All farmer/growers must grow the food they are selling within New Hampshire or roughly 30 miles of Plymouth NH, with product preference for farmers within 30 miles of Plymouth, NH.

All farmer/growers must be willing to deliver their products to Plymouth on the day and time designated for pickup (currently Thursdays at 2:30pm).

Eligibility of products:

All products must be grown, raised, and/or made by the farm or farmer stated on the application.

Products must be of high quality and considered food – ie produce, dairy, meat, eggs, baked goods, etc.

Baked goods – the named ingredient (ie blueberries in Blueberry Scone; herbs in Herb Bread) must be NH grown. We encourage farmers to use as many local ingredients as possible, and to advertise this fact when writing product descriptions)

Each vendor is solely responsible for the quality of their product.

Local Foods Plymouth does not allow any substitutions or returns.

There is no fee for farmers to participate. Farmer income from sales is deducted by 5% for fees, primarily to Paypal – the company that handles online fund transfers. Payment is made the first week of the month for the prior month's sales.
