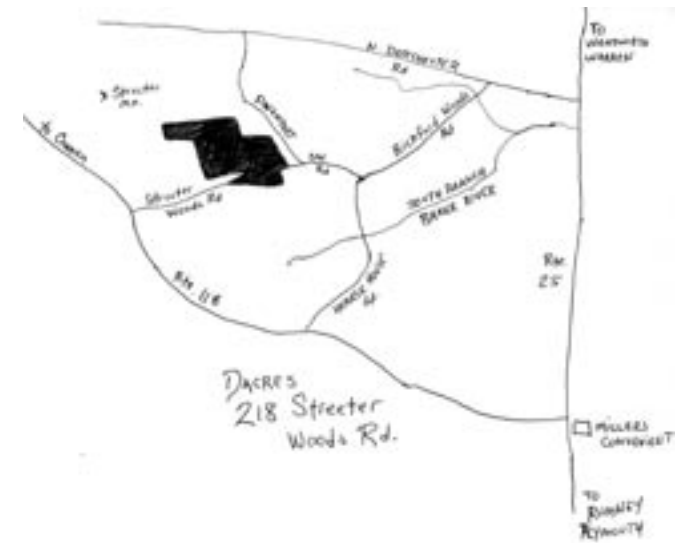
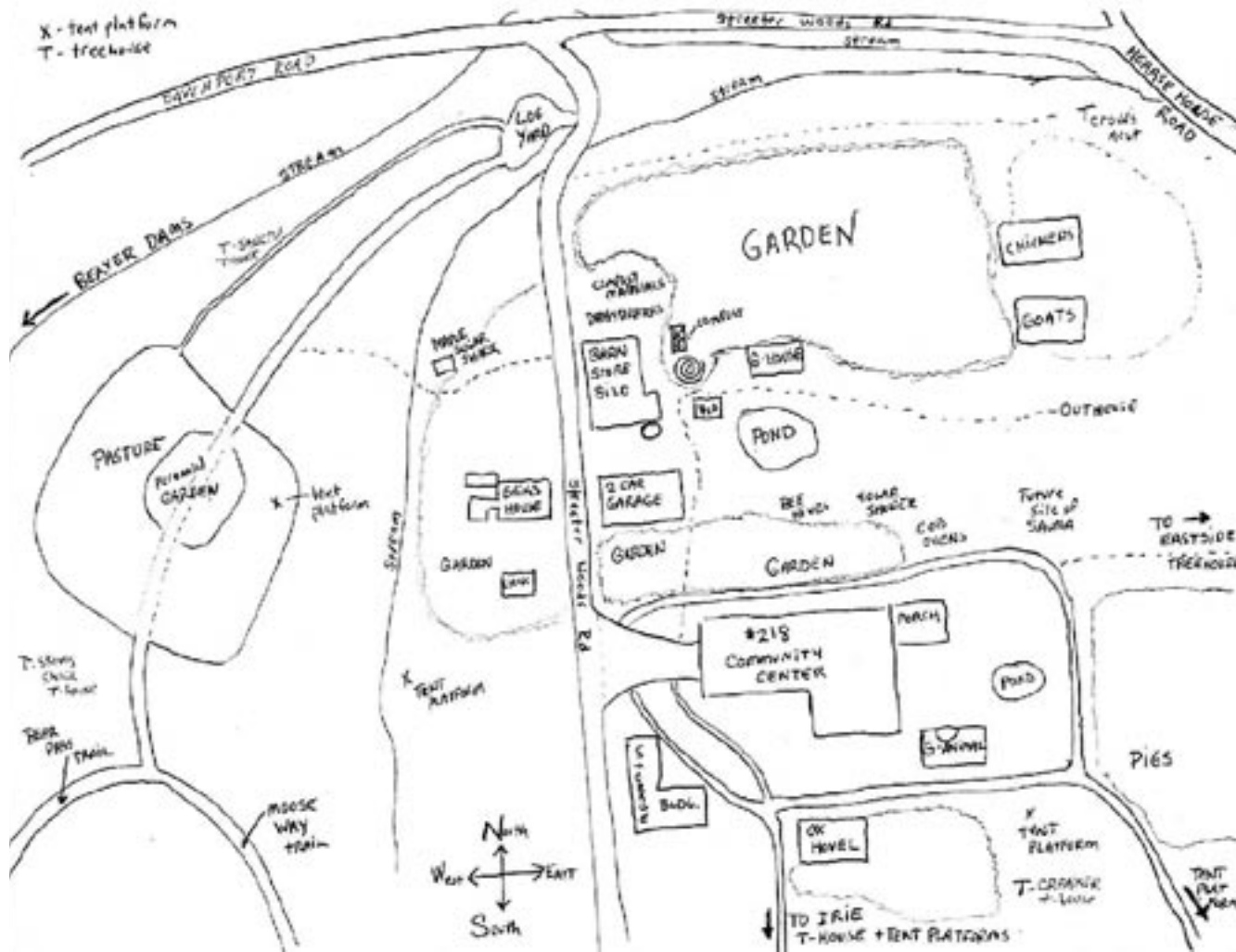


# D ACRES TRAIL GUIDE

**D Acres of New Hampshire** is an innovative tax-exempt non-profit based in rural Dorchester, NH. The organization is a small, grassroots, farm-based environmental education center that promotes sustainable practices. We utilize 180 acres of land as a demonstration site for educational opportunities relating to organic gardening, sustainable forestry, alternative eco-building, renewable energy, organic food preservation, mutualistic animal husbandry, and wood crafting. Educational opportunities include a series of 25-30 workshops each year and two internship/workstudy programs. We welcome more than 2000 visitors a year for tours of our integrated farm system, including the woodland trails identified on this map.
